

The fee is £42 per team. Cheques made payable to Wimbledon Fencing Club, for alternative method of payment please contact the organiser. The first seven entries received with Payment will be entered (Composite teams will be accepted if clubs can not make up full teams). This event can only be run if the entry is sufficient to make it financially viable, so please return your entries as soon as possible.

**Format:** Each team is made up of 6 fencers 2 Foilists, 2 Epeeists and 2 Sabreurs who can be male or female. The competition consists of two rounds. Round one is a seeding round, the top four

female. The competition consists of two rounds. Round one is a seeding round, the top four enter pool 1 and the lowest four enter pool 2 for the second round. In round two all fencers are awarded scores for their final position, 16 for the highest and 1 for the lowest. Each club's scores are added together for the final result. **A full days fencing for all fencers.**
