South East Region Sabre Championships

- 2. Organiser: Ian de Whalley, 7 Auriol Park Road, Worcester Park, KT4 7DP. Payment per entry form.
- 3. Venue: St. Peters School, Horseshoe Lane East, Guildford GU1 2TN (See map on p2).
- 4. Report times: Individual: by 9:30. Team: 12:15pm... might overlap AGM / end of individual.
- 5. If you enter in advance (with valid BFA number) then you don't have to show evidence of BFA membership at check-in.
- 6. The team sabre entry fee is £18/team. Team entries in advance are welcome but you are also welcome to form teams on the day. Members of a team do not have to be from the same club / county and may be mixed (men/women). Ideally please inform organiser in advance if you'd like to fence in the team event (add note in box at bottom of entry form).
- 7. Format: Poules then DE (separate men's / women's). Teams of 3 (mixed) compete by 45-hit relay.
- 8. Referees: Please referee for each other.
- Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves
 the right to deem kit unsafe. Plastrons and gloves rated for the 800Newtons level, (i.e. CEN2) are
 mandatory.
- 10. All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 11. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see www.BritishFencing.com).
- 12. Please do bring you own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on you cleaning up your own mess.
- 13. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
- 14. This competition will be sharing a venue with an epee competition and also a brief Region AGM (2pm).
- 15. Trophies: There are cups for the men's individual winner and the women's individual winner.

 These cups are engraved in memory of Roger Barnes, our past SE Region chairman. Also medals for top 3 women and top 3 men.
- 16. There are separate medals for top 3 women's intermediates and top 3 men's intermediates. Classification as intermediate is <u>linked here</u> (organisers discretion takes precedence).
- 17. Any changes or announcements will be posted at www.SurreyFencing.com (also linked from the Region website www.southeastregionfencing.org.uk).


Local directions

St Peters Catholic Comprehensive School Horseshoe Lane East Merrow, Guildford GU1 2TN

The entrance is on Horseshoe Lane <u>East</u>. Ignore your satnav if it tells you to turn into Grasmere Close – there is an error in some e-Maps.

Enter the school by the main gate. The sports hall is ahead of you, behind building works for a new sixth-form centre.

Parking is permitted in the playground. Please drive slowly on school grounds there may be children arriving for football.



Arriving by car from London or M25 J10

Take the A3 towards Guildford, and leave the A3 at the Burpham exit. Drive straight on towards Guildford at the next four roundabouts, and turn left at a larger roundabout signposted to A25 Dorking. Turn left at the traffic lights at the end of the road, onto Epsom Road - which is both the A25 and A246 at this point - towards Leatherhead and Dorking,

Horseshoe Lane East is the second on the left after the speed camera.

Arriving by car from central Guildford

From the centre of Guildford, or from the Guildford exit of the A3, follow signs to A25 Dorking or to A246 Leatherhead. You will join the route described above, either at the roundabout just past Spectrum or at the traffic lights on Epsom road.

Arriving by Public Transport

It's about 40 minutes by foot from London Road station, or a taxi ride from Guildford main station.

Unfortunately the local buses are infrequent on Sundays, and only one – the number 27/37 leaving Friary Bus Station at 09:36 – is timetabled to arrive in time. Friary Bus station is about 10 minutes walk from Guildford rail station. The bus stop nearest the school is High Path Road.

Food and drink

There is no food or drink on sale at St Peter's. An M&S Food at the BP garage in Merrow is less than a mile away.
