2. Venue: Surrey Sport Park, Guildford, GU2 7XX. See [here for map](#)/instructions.
SatNav users note this postcode rather than the administrative postal address.
3. Report by 18:00 (confirmed). Please be prompt.
4. BF Cards: Membership of British Fencing is a condition of entry.
Please show any evidence of membership (eg confirmation email) at check-in.
5. Team members should either live or fence in Surrey (which for this purpose includes London south of the Thames and west of the Ravensbourne River). If in doubt consult the organiser.
6. Each team may have any combination of men and women (no separate events).
7. Format: At organisers discretion. If there are 6 or less teams then a poule unique is likely. With more entries, poules then DE is likely and the start time might have to be moved earlier (any updates would be announced here).
8. All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
9. All fencers must participate in accordance with BF Safety Guidelines (see [BF website](#)).
10. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory, per BF rules. 800N gloves are required. Mask wires may be any colour.
11. Referee: Please expect to referee each other. If you can bring a referee, this will improve the competition.
12. Please do bring your own provisions but do not consume or spill them in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink. Water only in the hall pls.
13. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
