5. Team captain to pay £28 entry fee per team, at check-in. Discount to £24 if you pay before we start!

6. Teams are of three fencers. You may substitute a reserve during a match if you wish provided they were nominated (record on pool sheet) before the match starts. If there is sufficient interest in a separate ladies team event then that may be arranged.

7. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.

8. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit considered to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory.

9. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see <u>www.BritishFencing.com</u>).

10. Age restriction: All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.

11. Blade size restrictions: Any size in the range 0 to 5 allowed.

12. Bring your own provisions but please do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.

13. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
