Entry fee £15 in advance or £20 if paid on the day, cheques payable Surrey County Fencing Union.

Either way please enter via the website. Please write the competitors name on the back of the cheque.

1. Venue: Sports Hall, Epsom College, Longdown Lane, Epsom, KT17 4JQ.



There maybe a few additional parking places behind the sports hall (parking is likely to be busy).

No dogs please.

2. Report Times: (Event progress may depend on how many referees volunteer)...

U14 09:00 (Born 1998 or 1999) U16 &U18 11:00 (Born 1994 to 1997) U12 13:00 (Born 2000 to 2002)

- 3. BFA\* Cards: Please show evidence of BFA membership at check-in (a home print eg email or BFA web profile is OK). This is important because of possible complications regarding the BYC finals qualification.
- 4. BYC<sup>+</sup> Finals: A minimum of four fencers in each event qualify for the British Youth Championships finals.
  I recommend that you read the BYC finals rules (expected to become available via BFA website). Note that to claim a bye you must enter this qualifier AND inform the organiser of this qualifier that you are claiming your bye (you do not have to fence). Unclaimed byes may be forfeited.
- 5. If you need paper details for the BYC finals then please request them from the organisers of this event.
- 6. Referees: We are likely to be short of adult referees for this event. If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition. If clubs wish to reserve a coach for coaching / supervising then please bring additional referees as well. Would fencers capable of refereeing please referee on request. At organisers discretion referees may be offered refreshments and a contribution towards expenses.
- 7. Electric apparatus: Some boxes may have old timing. Would clubs please send a set if possible. We may rely on this. Please notify organiser how many sets you can bring.
- 8. <u>Kit</u>: Please note all events will be "electric". You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. For U12 & U14, Epee blades must be size 2 or smaller. Plastrons (800N for U16&U18) and breeches are mandatory.
- 9. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. A parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you object to photography then consult the organiser before check-in.
- 10. Any changes or announcements will be posted at www.SurreyFencing.com (+ results soon after the event).
- 11. There will not be a cafeteria / food / drink available on site so please bring your own. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink. Please keep the floor clean... water only in the hall...food & other drinks elsewhere please. Please clear litter.
- 12. You may only enter one regions' qualifier for the BYC. Even if you move or live and fence in multiple regions then only enter qualifiers in one region per season.
- 13. Organisers are not loco-parentis. All children to be accompanied by an adult

I hope we will have a great day of fencing and that many South East fencers will qualify for the BYC Finals on 5th-7th May 2012 (see BFA Web site for details).
