
Surrey County Fencing Union Epee Championships (Individual)

- 3. Report by 09:30 (earlier please eg 09:10 your entry / payment is incomplete).
- Membership of the British Fencing Association is required.
 For late entries please be ready to show any evidence of membership (eg confirmation email) at check-in.
- 5. Entrants who do not live or fence in Surrey (which for this purpose areas up to the Thames, including from Rotherhithe down to Croydon, which used to be part of Surrey) may compete but will be excluded from the Surrey results/medals.
- 6. A separate womens competition will be held if sufficient numbers enter, else men's & womens events will be combined (in which case separate trophies would be awarded to the highest placed women).
- 7. All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see BFA website).
- 9. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory, per BFA rules.
- 10. Referee: Please expect to referee each other. If you can bring a referee, this will improve the competition.
- 11. Please do bring you own provisions but do not consume or spill them in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink. Water only in the hall please.
- 12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you object to photography then consult the organiser.
