Also submitting the form on-line helps (optional online payment accepted – see website).
2. Venue: Epsom College, Longdown Lane South, Epsom KT17 4JJ [map](#) (no dogs or smoking).
3. Report: 9:30am, start 9:45 (same time for men and women to allow events to combine if one is small).
4. British Fencing Membership is required; preferably supply names+numbers in advance .
5. Teams are of three fencers. You may substitute a reserve during a match if you wish provided they were nominated (record on pool sheet) before the match starts. If there is sufficient interest in a separate women's team event then that may be arranged.
6. Referees: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
7. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory. If your mask has no lame, please try to get & fit one.
8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BF Safety Guidelines (see [www.BritishFencing.com](http://www.BritishFencing.com)).
9. Age restriction: All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
10. Blade size restrictions: Any size in the range 0 to 5 allowed.
11. Please do bring your own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form and this authorises photography. If there is any objection to photography then consult the organiser (before entering).
13. Cancellations before the event day: Contact the organiser if you have to cancel... we value early entries and will refund as much as we can where we feel it's appropriate to do so.
