- 4. Please either enter early or show evidence of BF membership at check-in (or equivalent, e.g. MPAG).
- 5. Format: You will fence all the other competitors in a giant (mixed) "Poule Unique" on many pistes. The time limit is 1 minute. Any double hits scored will not count. After 1 minute if there has been no victor, the match will be called a double defeat. Although the event is mixed, there are separate trophies and medals for the top three women as well as men.
- 6. Referees: Please referee and floor spot for each other.
- 7. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons (rated for at least the 800Newtons level, i.e. CEN2) are mandatory.
- 8. All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 9. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see www.BritishFencing.com).
- 10. Blade size restrictions: BFA rules apply (any size 1 to 5 allowed).
- 11. Please do bring you own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on you cleaning up your own mess.
- 12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
- 13. Just for info: A youth team match may share the venue.
- 14. Preferably arrive already changed to reduce changing room segregation issues.
